- Fairfax Software was selected by a large southeastern state's Department of Revenue after a competitive procurement to replace their current Image Management System. The solution includes *Quick* Modules 5.0 for capturing and processing forms and payments and Hyland® OnBase® for Document Content Management. *Quick* Modules 5.0 software processes all images captured from a variety of sources including Kodak® 660, OPEX® 7.5 IEM®, OPEX® DS2200, and OPEX Falcon® mail opening and scanning equipment. Tabletop Fujitsu® scanners in 61 remote locations statewide will also be adding work to the system. *Quick* Modules 5.0 allows the state to retire aging Burroughs® Quantum check transports. In addition to processing work for the Department of Revenue, work for other state agencies including Child Support will be processed by the system.
- Fairfax Software was selected by a large mid-atlantic state's Department of Motor Vehicles after a competitive procurement to replace their current Remittance Processing System. The solution includes *Quick* Modules 5.0 and OPEX® Falcon® scanners. The state-of-the art solution will process all inbound mixed size forms and payments managed by a single intelligent workflow. Virtual batching will help reduce labor costs by eliminating most manual sorts.
- Fairfax Software's *Quick* MV system has been selected for processing vehicle registrations and title work by the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles. *Quick* MV is a hosted web-based application featuring real-time verification by the National Motor Vehicle Title and Information System (NMVITAS) database and is available to Indiana dealers that buy and sell vehicles in the state.

ARE YOU READY FOR THE 2020 NACHA RULE CHANGES ?

The National Clearing House Association (NACHA) that governs ACH processing has announced rule changes that go into effect in 2020. If you are depositing checks via ACH, these rules may affect you. These rules do not apply to checks deposited via Check 21. Check 21 rules are set by the Federal Reserve.

1. Effective March 1, 2020, the dollar limit for a single ACH same day transaction will increase to \$100,000.
2. Effective April 1, 2020, the Originating Deposit Financial Institution (ODFI) and the Originator will have clearer return codes when a transaction is returned. Code R10 will mean “No Authorization and code R11 will mean “Transaction Error”. Previously both conditions would return an R10 code.
3. Effective June 30, 2020, originators that are not Financial Institutions, Third-Party Senders, and Third-Party Service Providers with 6,000,000 or more annual transactions must render deposit account information unreadable when electronically storing it. Originators with volumes of 2 million or more have until June 30, 2021 to comply.
