4,500 Colorado users depend on *QuickTags* to assign a temporary registration when a vehicle is sold by a dealer. When the registration is complete, the bold new temporary tags are printed and the new owner is ready to roll.

Tag numbers are managed by a database and assigned to a vehicle at the time of registration. Dealers, law enforcement, and DMV personnel have controlled access to the system.

Recent legislation was signed by the Governor to afford licensed drivers the opportunity to register to vote when they obtain or renew their driver's license. The contract involves the installation of twenty new OPEX FalconRED™ scanning units to assist with processing envelopes containing driver's license renewal and voter registration information along with the payment. Images and data are automatically input to *Quick* Modules for processing. This system is just another example of the CA DMV's progressive offerings of non-DMV services to better enhance the ease of obtaining state government services.
