Electronic Presentment of Checks Earns ROI for City of VA Beach!

The City of Virginia Beach Treasurer Department (John T. Atkinson City Treasurer) processes the City's water bills and property taxes; over 3 million images per year with a peak of 12,000+ payments per day.

Before Check 21, the City used a two pass encoding solution. To ensure timely deposits during peak processing, the City borrowed resources from data entry to encode checks. There were many times City personnel worked until late at night and on weekends.

Solution

The City of Virginia Beach chose Check 21. Because Quick Modules is modular and scalable, it was a straightforward process to add our Quick Check 21 module and our image retrieval module which enables other departments to access images of checks and invoices.

"People in the water department retrieve images of checks instantly," said Joyce Siverd, Deputy Treasurer. "Before, we had to find the checks and fax them. Now, I can email a check image to a customer or another department."

Benefits

With the new system, the City saw improvements in payment processing. Operating expenses are reduced. Deposits are made the day checks arrive.

"On the first day of tax season, we were done before 5:00 PM!" said Joyce Siverd.

"We used to come in every weekend, during tax season. Now we might come in one weekend."

"For the most part, every check gets deposited the day it arrives," said Francisco Domingo, Account Clerk Supervisor.

Tax revenue becomes available to the City on the day payments arrive. One measurable return on investment is a 20% reduction of the cost of depositing checks.

"I attended conferences on Check 21 and heard problems," said Joyce Siverd. "We have not experienced any."

"Yes," added Francisco Domingo. "We thought money orders would be an issue with dark colored backgrounds. We have the same success with money orders that we have with checks."
